RAINY DAY DROP OFF AND PICK UP SCHEDULE

**Student having breakfast should go directly to cafeteria. Students are not to enter the cafeteria through the Library or school office.*

Morning: **Kindergarten – 3rd Grade:**
Students should report directly to the cafeteria using the Brandon Bowl entrance.

4th – 6th Grade:
Students should report directly to the Multipurpose Room.

Teachers will pick-up their students from these locations and escort class to their room.

Afternoon: All students are dismissed through the front of the school, under awning in north and south playgrounds. Students with bicycles may exit from the south playground.

MINIMUM DAY SCHEDULE

- **Fall Parent/Teacher Conference Days** 12:00 p.m. dismissal for all grades
- **Spring Parent/Teacher Conference Days** 12:00 p.m. dismissal for all grades
- **Last Day of School Dismissal:** K – 11:45 a.m., grades 1 through 6 – 11:40 a.m.

Playground supervisors are on the north and south playground at 7:30 a.m. daily, **no early drop-offs**. A playground supervisor is on the north and south playground until 3:15 p.m. everyday except Thursday. (2:15 on Thursday). There is no after school supervision for kindergarteners.

Recess schedules may vary on an individual grade level basis due to specialists' schedules or field trips on a particular day. Daily instructional minutes remain the same.
